### MOVABLE COLLECTION -HOSPITALITY HUB

UAC is pleased to partner with the Hospitality Hub to commission new artwork for three areas inside the new barrier-free women's shelter under construction in downtown Memphis, funded by the City of Memphis' Movable Collection.

The Hospitality Hub provides vital services to the unhoused population in Memphis and the new women's shelter is designed to facilitate healing from trauma and introduce immediate stability to unsheltered lives. Paired with top-tier, 24/7 case management, emergency shelter provides a necessary baseline for rebuilding a life.

### NEW PUBLIC ARTISTS

UAC launched the inaugural New Public Artist Fellowship in partnership with the University of Memphis Department of Art in 2021 with support from ArtsMemphis and Perkins Everett Lighting & Controls. NPA is an intensive professional development program for artists who are interested in expanding their artistic practices and pursuing large-scale sculpture commissions.

The selection committee for the fellowship prioritized awarding the opportunity to artists of color and women - as a primary goal for the program is to address the lack of diversity and equity in the field of public sculpture.



### NEW PUBLIC ARTISTS

In 2022, NPA fellows installed temporary public art projects on the University of Memphis campus as the conclusion to the program. A group show highlighting the studio work of the fellows was also installed in the Fogelman Galleries at the university.

We are incredibly pleased to have opened a new Call to Artists this year for the 2023 NPA Fellowship, with support from the Tennessee Arts Commission.








### MEMPHIS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT


In February 2022, UAC was honored to support the unveiling of the new public art collection for the B Concourse at the Memphis International Airport. Beginning in 2020, UAC worked closely with the Memphis Shelby County Airport Authority and design and construction teams to create a world class art program for the concourse. Over 60 artists based in and connected to Memphis are represented in five site-specific public art commissions, four rotating installations, and a collection of 44 artworks installed in the gates throughout the concourse. All five of the site-specific installations were led by Memphis artists.

The collection as a whole represents the wildly vibrant and dynamic creative community coming from Memphis and has been continuously celebrated as both locals and visitors to our city travel through our renovated airport.









### NEIGHBORHOOD ART INITIATIVE

In the last year, UAC has continued to expand the Neighborhood Art Initiative (NAI) through commissioning four new projects for the Douglass, Hickory Hill, Mallory Heights and Westwood neighborhoods. NAI invites neighborhood leaders and organizations to apply to UAC for public art funds for their communities and to collaboratively develop the scope and needs for the project.

These four neighborhoods were selected in 2021 and the team began working closely with neighborhood partners in each to identify the greatest priorities for new projects.

artists to create artistic enhancements to bus shelters in the Mallory Heights community that refresh the existing shelters and reflect a strong sense of community and family pride.




#### **WESTWOOD**

## REVISITING & RESPONDING

This program invites artists of various disciplines to create temporary or performative projects in response to existing public art, specific spaces, and relevant social and cultural exchanges.

In 2022, Brittney Boyd Bullock created a response to Nancy Cheairs' colorful sculptures for the children's area at the Benjamin L. Hooks Library by transforming the space with yards of her printed fabric panels suspended amongst the trees. Her installation, titled "I'm New Here", featured a live choral performance from the Freedom Singers led and Directed by Justin Merrick, Executive Director of the Center for Transforming Communities - an organization dedicated to building up the cultural, economic, social, physical and municipal health of neighborhoods.









### PUBLIC ART PUBLIC JOY

As we all ventured out into the world more this year, UAC hosted several beautiful gatherings to help people engage with public art installations and our team. Together, we celebrated new mural dedications, visited classrooms to give presentations, and even took a group of artists to attend an inspiring opening exhibition in Mississippi.

In partnership with the Yoga Kickback, Hot Yoga Plus, and Drip Yoga, free yoga classes were offered in Audubon Park and the Renasant Convention Center with public art by Greely Myatt and Kaleob Elkins and Franklin Wallace respectively. UAC also hosted an artist happy hour at the Arrive Hotel where guests enjoyed our signature cocktail of the evening "the public art collector" while mingling and learning more about one another.
